#### **Sink Blockages**

Sink waste pipe problems can be a pain at home, but doubly so in a caravan. Pipes delivering caravan waste water, or 'grey water', are made to a corrugated, or riffled design. This is because riffled tubes are very flexible and can easily be bent into tight curve shapes without kinking. Curves are necessary to reach locations that may need to trace around obstructions, but the corrugations offer traps for any solid particles that travel within the waste water. Another advantage of corrugated tubing is that being flexible, it is most unlikely to be damaged by vibration, and caravans do undergo plenty of vibration.

The first lesson to avoid drainage problems must, therefore, be to ensure that little or no solid particles are allowed to go down the sink waste outlet. This means care with washing up and thoroughly clearing plates before putting them into the sink water.

Ideally, a small square of fine metal gauze could stop this, but such gauze is not easy to come across, although an equivalent chromed metal disc with perforations is to be found in kitchen item outlets.

Even with care, a fatty coating soon builds up on the inside of waste pipes and dries out after use. The long delay until the next coating produces a concreted layer and eventually a blockage occurs.

There are several options to cure blockages. The first method is to employ achemical drain cleaner, probably alkaline, like washing soda. The non-chemical solution is to use a flexible rod, like curtain wire, with a screw eye hook in the end. This usually clears most blockages if it is gently rotated whilst being steadily pushed down the pipe. If the wire goes all through the length of the waste pipe, it is pretty certain that the problem has been solved. A kettle full of boiling watershould follow, to rinse out the inside of the pipe.

If this problem has occurred in your caravan in the past, it is probably worth keeping a length of curtain wire coiled up, in the front locker.

In extreme cases, if the wire treatment does not clear an obstruction, the whole waste pipe must be removed and a rigid rod used, but with care, this will never be necessary.

As always in such matters, prevention is better than cure.

# Information sheet No 11 Unit Safety Spacing

#### RALLY STEWARDS' GUIDE TO SAFETY SPACING OF UNITS

A minimum space of six metres in any direction between units (including any form of awning) must be maintained, both as a fire break and as a clear access route for emergency vehicles to any unit on site. Units should ideally be staggered in relation to those in the next line and all units in a line should face in the same direction to facilitate rapid and unconfused removal in an emergency situation. Stewards should consider the risk of fire being propagated between units as a result of the close proximity of units to a combusible fixed structure on the site. A minimum space of six metres must be left between any unit and any fixed structure considered to be of combustible nature. In building construction; concrete, brick and structural steel are noncombustible and wood is combustible. If in doubt leave a six metre space or consult a fire prevention professional for advice.

The Natural England guide says not less than three metres should be permitted between units. For this purpose, a unit includes the caravan/tent plus any awning, gazebo or "pup" tent and the tow car (which should be parked on the "blind side" of the unit and can normally be quickly moved in the case of an emergency).

Many stewards equip themselves with a six metre length of rope with which to simply measure off from the wall of the last sited unit (or awning if erected) to the required position of the wall of the next arrival. Alternatively, it is sometimes possible to mark pitches out in advance and in such cases – provided that all units are uniformally sited on the marker (e.g front right corner) and using average caravan (2.4m) and awning (2.5m) specifications – 8.4 metres is required between pitch markers, or 10.9 metres allowing for an awning to be erected. Should you wish to site the units in a "herringbone" formation, this equates to approximately 8.8m or 11.6m respectively. Of course, unless specifications and intentions are declared on the rally booking slips, it is not always possible to know what size or types of unit are to be expected or who will be erecting awnings so, in the absence of this information and provided the size of the rally field permits, it is advantageous to pre-mark out the pitches under the assumption that every unit will be of maximum size and with an awning attached.

Tents of course come in many diverse shapes and sizes so these must be given particular consideration, especially if marking out the pitches in advance. They must be sited separately from caravans & motorhomes although that does not neccessfully mean segregated. If the layout of the field does not allow for separate lines of tents it is permissible to continue a line of caravans/motorhomes with a line of tents but they must be sited en bloc and not be interspersed. Trailer tents are classified as tents and must be sited accordingly.

Children's "pup" tents may be erected alongside the parents' unit and should be considered as part of the unit for spacing purposes.

#### **Please Note**

In order to permit the attendance of tents & trailer tents (with the exception of children's "pup" tents) on caravan rallies a Camping Exemption Certificate, issued by Natural England under section 269 of the Public Health Act 1936, must be held in conjunction with the Caravan Exemption Certificate.


The diagram shown overleaf is intended only as an example to illustrate the safety spacing required in any possible scenario.


