- Window fitting not normally possible in a Ducato panel van but enabled with my bespoke passenger window assembly that can be bolted together and simply drops into the empty passenger window space
- Can be assembled and installed by one person but helps if another person can slide the lighter internal unit through the window space. (The two units are permanently linked)
- Needs mains hookup but under 2 amps. Not considered suitable for an inverter over extended hours
- Any Disadvantages? Yes has to be set up but can be done fairly quickly. Fine for me when in one place for a few days
- Other Major Disadvantage? Yes it is quite bulky. Would not conveniently store inside a Murvi and too high to fit under the seats, but again was fine for me with the rear storage of the XL. Other options possible.
- Reason for sale? Replacement Murvi with habitation air conditioning built it.
- Used only three times and, on confirmation of purchase, could possibly be seen and confirmed working, by arrangement, if distances are not unreasonable.
- Cool My Camper are out of stock for the season. Says it all.
